My name is Wynne Norton I'm an assistant professor in the Department of Health Behavior in the School of Public Health at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. I'm also an investigator in the Center for Implementation Practice and Research Support at the VA Greater Los Angeles. I'm also a second year fellow this year in 2011 in the implementation and research institute here at Washington University at St. Louis. My work is focused at the intersection of implementation science in HIV prevention, treatment and engagement in care interventions, with a particular focus on sustainability as well as scale up and spread.

I also run the Dissemination and Implementation in Health ListServ which provides monthly updates of recently published abstracts of dissemination and implementation related articles in health care as well as public health. I began this with a couple colleagues several years ago in 2007 and have been running it ever since. It also provides updates on funding opportunities, grant announcements, and related announcements to the D&I community covering researchers, practitioners, and policy makers in both health care and public health.
